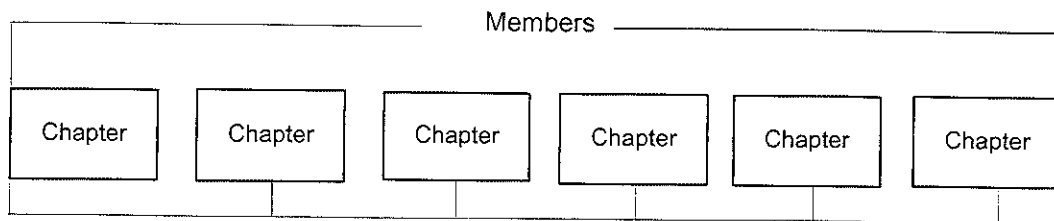


## CTA Governance Structure

Governance in the California Teachers Association begins at the local, or chapter level. By secret ballot, members elect their own chapter officers as well as representatives to CTA's policy-making State Council of Education and delegates to NEA's Representative Assembly. The more than 712 State Council representatives, each of whom represents members in designated geographic districts throughout the State, in turn elect the three state-level CTA officers and the CTA Board of Directors. Special interest committees function through both the Council and the Board.
