

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN THE WASHINGTON UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
AND THE
WASHINGTON TEACHERS ASSOCIATION

- PARTIES:** This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into between the Washington Unified School District (WUSD) and the Washington Teachers Association (WTA) as of November 4, 2016.
- PURPOSE:** The purpose of this MOU is to allow sites to utilize more than one Teacher-in-Charge in a given school year, and to specify a maximum stipend for this position per site.
- TERM:** This MOU shall become effective upon the date of execution by both WUSD and WTA and shall remain in force for the 2016-2017 school year.

IT IS AGREED:

1. An elementary school principal may designate more than one teacher-in-charge during a particular school year if it can be shown to be of benefit to students.
2. The maximum stipend for all teachers-in-charge at a particular site during a school year shall be \$1,400.00.
3. If the combined number of days that teachers-in-charge serve at a site during a school year exceeds 15 days, then the teachers-in-charge shall share the stipend equitably, based upon the number of days each has served.
4. Except for that enumerated above, Article 17.8 shall remain in force.

REPRESENTATION OF AUTHORITY:

The undersigned hereby represent and warrant that they are authorized by the respective parties to execute this MOU.
